



2009 Summer Camp Programs

Ages: Preschool thru Grade 1

June 15-18	Let's go Fly a Kite	Children will learn what is needed to make a kite fly. They will construct and test out their flying skills.
June 22-25	Tennis	A very relaxed introduction to this traditional sport. Skill building activities will be introduced throughout the week with a real match by the end of the week.
June 29-July 2	All Creatures Great And Small	Children will be exposed to the wide variety of animals in our region and learn about their habitat. We'll be hiking to examine animal tracks and their scat to identify the animal.
July 6- 9	Tee-Ball	Children will learn the basic skills needed for baseball/softball and rules for the sport.
July 13- 16	Soccer	Children will learn basic skills needed for soccer and the rules for the sport.
July 20-23	Flower Power	Children will be looking closely at different flowers and plants in our area, labeling them by name, dissecting them and learning about their different parts.
July 27- 30	Art	Children will have the opportunity to work with clay, paint, beads, and more and will incorporate the natural environment into their art projects.
Aug 3-6	Stream Stomp	Children will learn about the water cycle, the animals living in the stream and the importance of water conservation.
Aug 10-13	Creepy Crawlies	Children will take a closer look at insects in our area and learn about the different types they find. Any fears of creepy crawlies will be addressed!
Aug 17-20	Outdoor Survival	Children will learn basic skills in mapping, shelter making and animal safety.
Aug 24-27	Dinosaurs	Children will learn about the different types of dinosaurs, will be doing an "archeological dig" and examine their findings just like archeologists.

A \$100 deposit is required to pre-register your child for our summer program(s). The deposit is fully refundable at the end of the summer if you've followed the rules of enrollment below:

- 1- Payment in full is due on the 1st of each month for the next month's enrollment or before your camp week.
- 2- A valid credit card is required upon enrollment. Your credit card will be charged in full for the next month's enrollment if cash or check has not been received by the 5th by the end of the camp week.
- 3- A \$20 late fee will be assessed on all late payments, except when your credit card is charged and is not declined.
- 4- Credit is not given for sick days, vacation days or days missed beyond the control of Morningstar Learning Center.
- 5- A \$2 per minute late charge will be assessed for each minute your child is picked up after 1pm or 4pm. Out of respect for our teachers and fairness to the children in our care, please pick up your child on time!
- 6- 14 days written notice is required to cancel your child's enrollment for a full refund.
