# RESOLUTION: SNOW AND NOXIOUS WEED ROAD MANAGEMENT

### RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Big Sky Owners Association, Inc. ("Association") is filed with the Montana Secretary of State as a public benefit, nonprofit Montana Corporation; and

WHEREAS, the Association's Amended and Restated Bylaws (Article 3, Section 3.2.1) assigns the Board of Directors ("Board") all of the powers and duties necessary for the administration of the Association's affairs and for performing all responsibilities and exercising all rights of the Association as set forth in the Governing Documents and as provided by law; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the Association will provide snowplowing of roads and noxious weed management along such roads as listed on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated by reference, for its members; and

WHEREAS, snowplowing is expensive, has safety and liability concerns, and has other related implications;

WHEREAS, infestation of noxious weeds in the Big Sky area has been determined to cause a variety of damage including reduced wildlife forage, alteration of water flow, soil erosion, and negative impacts to fisheries; and

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes the need to amend and supersede its policy adopted November 20, 1997, Policy No. 97-011; and

### NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that

- 1. All dedicated, public roads which are within the Association's jurisdiction, and are listed on Exhibit A shall be maintained for snow removal and otherwise maintained for noxious weed control by the Association.
- 2. Roads accessing condominium tracts, apartment units, or residences as listed on Exhibit A shall be snow plowed and otherwise maintained for noxious weeds only to the property line. Internal condominium/apartment loop/access roads will not be snow plowed or otherwise maintained for noxious weeds by the Association.
- 3. Private roads or roads that are not open to the public by means of an obstruction or gate will not be snow plowed or managed for noxious weeds. Roads that are not paved will not be snow plowed or managed for noxious weeds.

- 4. The owner of a lot or a sub-association representative located on a road within the Association's jurisdiction that is not listed on Exhibit A (or any addendum to Exhibit A) may petition the Board in writing to have their road snow plowed and/or managed for noxious weeds by the Association or request reimbursement for these services that are paid for by the owner or sub-association. The Board will make the determination whether or not to snow plow and/or otherwise maintain the road for noxious weeds and may consider the following criteria in their determination:
  - a. Whether the road to be snow plowed/otherwise maintained for noxious weeds is paved;
  - b. Whether the road is contiguous to a road that is already snow plowed/otherwise maintained for noxious weeds by the Association;
  - c. Whether the road services lots that are all owned by dues paying members and whether the road services other lots and sub-associations within the Association's jurisdiction;
  - d. If reimbursement is requested, the Board may only consider reimbursement if the snow plowing and/or noxious weed spraying is comparable to the level of service that would be provided by the Association and only if the cost to reimburse is less than if the Association provided those services.
  - e. The Board may take into consideration the cost of snow plowing/otherwise maintaining the road for noxious weeds relative to the assessments from the lots serviced by the road to be maintained; and
  - f. Other criteria as determined by the Board.
- 5. The Board interprets this resolution; its decision is final.
- 6. This Resolution supersedes all other Policies/Resolutions regarding snowplowing and/or noxious weed management by the Association (including Policy No: 97-011 and any amendments thereto).
