Lone Mountain Ski Passes

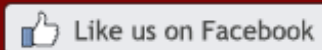
Winter has arrived! Lone Mountain Ranch will open its Nordic Trails and its Ski Rental Shop on December 7th. Make sure to swing by the BSOA office to get your Lone Mountain Ranch cross country season pass at our discounted price. It is one of the perks of being a BSOA member, so be sure to take advantage of it.



BSOA property owners and their immediate family, including children and spouses of children, are eligible to receive a pass for \$70.00. A maximum of 4 season passes per property at this price can be issued. Passes for children under 12 and Seniors over 70 are free! **A signed "Cross Country Ski Pass Terms and Conditions of Use" release must be received for every skier purchasing a seasons pass.** We do have day passes available for \$12.00 but dog passes must be purchased at Lone Mountain Ranch.

Passes can be purchased in the BSOA office. Cash, check, and credit card are all accepted.

With input from the BSAC, the BSOA Board has recently approved modifications to the Architectural Review Fees Schedule for BSOA construction projects. The intent for these modifications is to encourage efficiency with project application submissions, discourage the practice of bringing projects in multiple times for BSAC review, and reduce the amount of time spent reviewing projects by the BSAC volunteers and the Architectural Review Coordinator. This will also provide additional funding to support costs incurred for repetitious requests made to review a construction project.
