### **Rotary: People of Action**

Through the 35,000 Rotary Clubs worldwide, people are coming together to exchange ideas, and form friendships and professional connections while making a difference in their backyard and around the world. Your Big Sky Rotary Club has been making an impact through both local and international projects. In the past several years we handled the funding, construction and installation of four 911 Emergency call boxes in the no-cell zone in the Canyon

along 191. We funded and installed Climbing Walls and picnic tables in the Park, installed Visitor signage and painted trash cans in Town Center, funded a new Kayak Launch at Moose Creek Campground, and invested in Water Well Projects in Honduras, Zambia and Mexico. These are only a few of our many accomplishments.

Each year we team with other Rotarians worldwide to achieve our goal of eradicating polio from the world. As a result, more than 2.5 billion children have received vaccinations and polio cases have decreased by 99.9 percent.
